

NEW 2 METER LINKED REPEATER FOR THE SOUTHERN MENDOCINO COAST

As of May 12, 2009 there is a new linked 2 meter repeater on Fish Rock Road several miles north of Gualala.

The Frequency of this new repeater is **147.270 Mhz (+) 114.8** It has a positive offset of 600 khz with a PL of 114.8.

This repeater is linked to three other repeaters within Mendocino County and provides a vital communications link for the Southern Mendocino Coast to all of Mendocino County.

The other repeaters within Mendocino County that are linked to this new repeater are:

145.430 Mhz (-) Laytonville
147.390 Mhz (+) Ukiah
145.470 Mhz (-) Hopland
